

## 2019 Summer School Transportation

As PfISD continues to grow, the district remains committed to working to provide the highest quality services to its students and parents. In an effort to ensure greater consistency, reliability, and communication regarding summer school transportation, PfISD will be utilizing school campuses as hub locations for students to access buses to transport them to their respective summer programs along with several key neighborhood locations (see below), similar to last year. Using centralized hubs has proven to be a successful method throughout the state of Texas for summer transportation and ensures that summer routing remains consistent, on-time, and available year after year. This method also allows PfISD to communicate all summer transportation information early, providing students, parents, and summer program administrators with the time they need to prepare for summer program participation.

### Finding your stop location, times, and Bus number

All addresses located within PfISD district boundaries have a designated stop assignment. To determine the appropriate stop location for your address, go to the district website at [www.pfisd.net](http://www.pfisd.net). Click on the "**BUS ROUTE FINDER**" link at the top of the page. This will open the "**Infofinder i**" tab. Simply enter your address and click "Search". Find the school you will be attending and the designated stop location & times and the Bus number will be listed. Parmer Lane & Timmerman Elementary Schools and Weiss High School will host this year's Summer School programs. Students living in the HUB stop boundaries for the campus they are attending will see "No transportation provided".
