- Sept. 18 Chile's independence from Spain

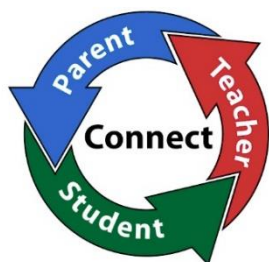


Candy Bar Fundraiser
