## **Electronic Devices and Technology Resources (All Grade Levels)**

For safety purposes, the district permits students to possess personal cell phones and telecommunications devices; however, these devices must remain turned off and completely powered down during the instructional day, unless they are being used for approved instructional purposes or during campus-approved times.

## Students shall not:

- use a telecommunications device, including a cellular telephone or smart watch, in violation of campus or district rules
- possess or use electronic devices during state-mandated or national testing
- use cell phones or any device capable of capturing images in locker rooms, dressing areas, or restrooms while at school or at a school-related or schoolsponsored event
- take photos, videos, text or make phone calls during class unless specifically directed to do so by the teacher for instructional purposes
- share personally-owned devices without parental permission
- use social media (e.g. Snapchat, Facebook, Twitter, etc.) for non-instructional purposes during the school day

If a student violates the campus guidelines for use of electronic devices:

- First incident device confiscation, parent notification, warning of additional consequences
- Second and subsequent incidents device confiscation, parent notification, \$15.00 fee for return of the phone to the parent
- Confiscated telecommunications devices that are not retrieved by the student or the student's parents will be disposed of after the notice required by law. [See policy FNCE.]

In limited circumstances and in accordance with law, a student's personal telecommunications device may be searched by authorized personnel. [See **Searches** and policy FNF.]

Any disciplinary action will be in accordance with the Student Code of Conduct. The district is not responsible for damaged, lost, or stolen telecommunications devices.

## Possession and Use of Other Personal Electronic Devices

Except as described below, students are not permitted to possess or use personal electronic devices, unless prior permission has been obtained. Unauthorized devices will be confiscated and turned in to the office for further administrative action, which may include parent contact to retrieve the items. In limited circumstances and in accordance with law, a student's personal electronic device may be searched by authorized personnel. [See **Searches** and policy FNF.]

Any disciplinary action will be in accordance with the Student Code of Conduct. The district is not responsible for any damaged, lost, or stolen electronic device.
