

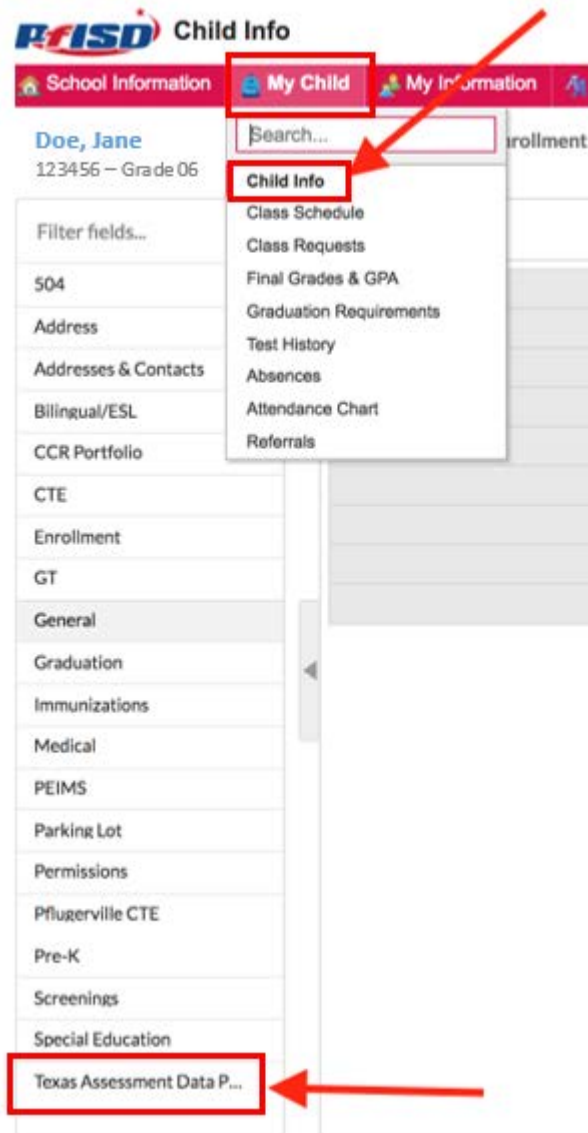

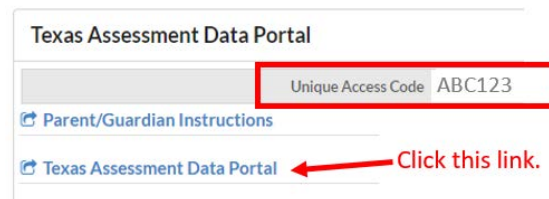
From “My Child” menu, choose “Child Info.”

Choose “Texas Assessment Data Portal” from menu on left.




Write down or highlight and copy the **Unique Access Code**. If the Unique Access Code is not available, see additional information at end of these instructions.

## Additional Information

If the Unique Access Code is not available in Focus, there are other ways to find this code. Each student will only have one Unique Access Code that will not change. This should be recorded and kept in a safe place with important family records.

First, refer to any copy of results from a state assessment from prior school years. The **Unique Access Code** will be at the very bottom of any Confidential Student Report (CSR) from prior years.

If a copy of a prior CSR is not available, see next step.

Enter the student's first name exactly as it appears on the birth certificate.


Enter the student's PEIMS ID. This is a 9-digit number that is usually the student's social security number.

For some student, the PEIMS ID is a 9-digit number that begins with an "S." Contact the campus your child most recently attended if you need help with the PEIMS ID.

Enter the student's date of birth and then click "Go."

For additional assistance, use the "Help" feature or contact the campus your child most recently attended.


