PfISD has not raised the paid or reduced status meal price in 5 years.




Middle & High School Dining


With our older students, health and wellness are incorporated throughout the dining space itself, where students are prompted to think about their own potential and healthy habits. Our goal is to help students make smart decisions that benefit their minds and nourish their bodies to drive success today and in the future.

Rally Cafe is our high school dining concept. Our Rally Cafes create an element of school spirit that was previously absent with older cafeteria concepts. Students have the opportunity to try new items that are not usually accustomed to the old, out-of-date cafeteria. This includes stir-fry, boneless chicken wings, nachos, and many more rotating food stations. With the recent installs at Hendrickson High and Weiss High, all four of our PfISD high school feature Aramark's Rally Cafe.

Lunch Pad is our new middle school concept. Students receive a more mature dining concept that will translate better to our Rally Cafe High School designs. Each line can be tailored to what the line is offering, i.e., tortilla, extras, main entree, pizza, salad, or deli. Like our high school concept, Lunch Pad is customizable and branded with the school mascot, making the space feel more aligned with each school the concept is in. This concept is currently featured at Pflugerville Middle School and Bohls Middle School, with more to be installed in the near future.

The Lone Star Chef Competition is Aramark's annual high school cooking competition. Students compete against other schools in a "Chopped" style contest, with the first-place school receiving scholarships. At Pflugerville ISD, we assist our Culinary Arts students at Connally High School in creating a dish that meets the competition guidelines. For us, this is a great opportunity to help aspiring chefs by giving them an outlet to compete and meet other aspiring chefs.
